- Manage the portfolio for assessment, intake and placement provision of young people and children with foster carers.
- Undertake comprehensive risk assessments and matching assessments to ensure children are placed within an appropriate foster carer family.
- Provide case management services to clients and achieve the desired outcomes.
- Provide relevant and current information with an ability to facilitate access to

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appropriate services where required.

- Provide a client focused approach which takes into account individual client needs.
- Provide support to the Carer Recruitment and Support team in their role of recruiting, training and retaining volunteer foster carers.
- Ensure that each individual placement is provided with necessary supports and interventions to promote long term stability.
- Deliver case management services that meet all relevant performance and outcome indicators.
- Work closely with the leadership team to improve processes and the delivery of the intake and recruitment service.
- Regularly liaise with Child Protection's Placement Coordiantion Unit to obtain referrals and advocate for supports to assist in placement planning.
- Manage the respite needs of foster carers.
- Maintain relevant statistics to monitor placement performance.
- Participate with the recruitment of foster carers.
